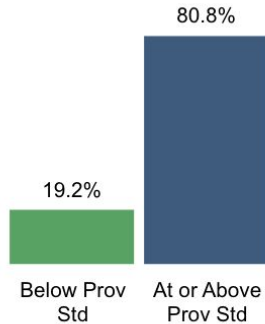

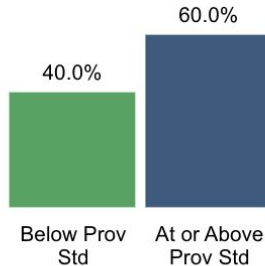

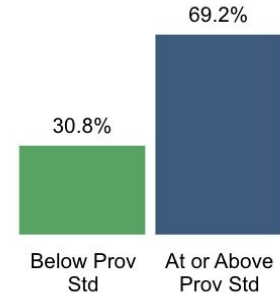
Results Rel. to Provincial Std. in Reading

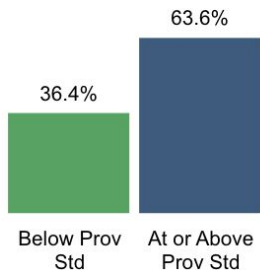

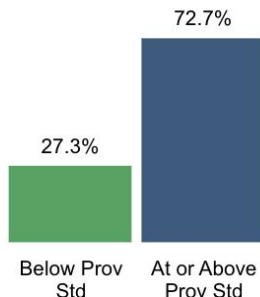

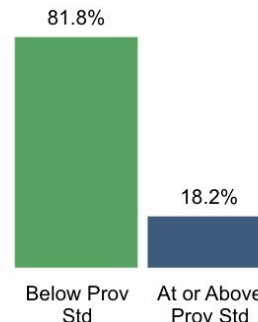
Results Rel. to Provincial Std. in Reading

School Improvement Plan Direction



Literacy

If intentional guided reading practice is a focus, then reading comprehension will improve as measured by running records and F & P reading assessment check-ins.

Numeracy

If we focus on incorporating intentional math games as an instructional practice, then automaticity/fluency will improve with basic math facts as measured by student growth on a fact tracker, the RDSB benchmarks.
