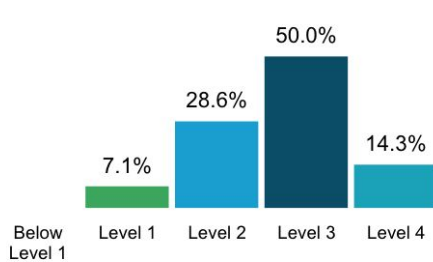

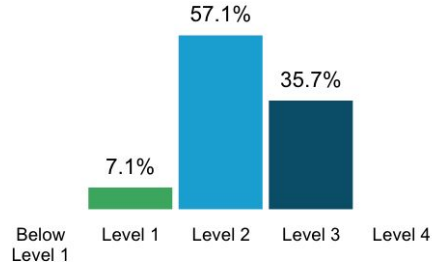

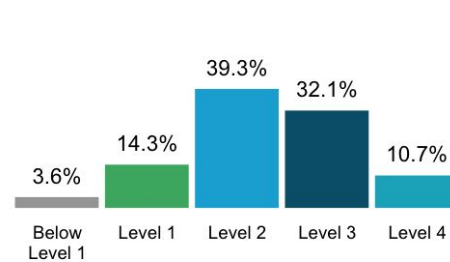
Results by Achievement Level in Reading

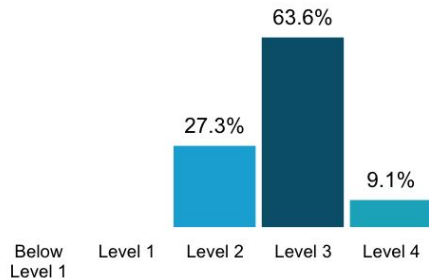

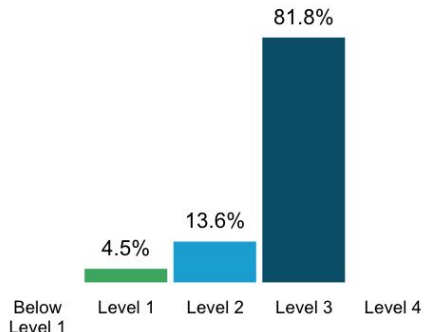

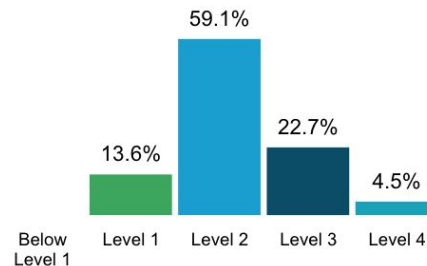
Results by Achievement Level in Reading
