SIP Goals



Reading:

- 1) 70% of all students will be reading at level 3 or higher in benchmark levels as measured by Acadience/BAS.
- 2) 90% of all students will respond yes to “I am a good reader,” and 100% will respond, “I am working hard and improving my reading skills.”

Writing:

- 1) Students in K-8 will write every day to build stamina (quantity), as well as develop ideas and organize writing coherently (quality) with support from graphic organizers.
- 2) 70% of students will achieve level 3 as measured by RDSB Writing Exemplars/TWR Intermediate Writing Diagnostics/EQAO assessments for grades 3 & 6.
- 3) 80% of all students will respond yes to “I am a good writer”, and 100% will respond, “I am working hard and improving my writing skills.”

Numeracy:

- 1) **All** classroom teachers will be using the RDSB Math Scope and Sequence (1-6)/Spiralling Document (7/8).
- 2) 70% of students will achieve a level 3 overall average on RDSB Math Broad Diagnostic tasks
- 3) 100% of students will respond yes to “I am working hard and improving my math skills,” and 80% will respond, “I am good at math.”

SIP Goals



CARE Kid - “Caring Adult Reaching Everyone” - 99% of our students believe they have at least one caring adult at school

3 specific students identified to staff - CARE NEEDED

-Staff also thinking about students that may be struggling with academics, attendance, mental health, positive self worth, etc.

-Staff are seeking them out to check in and offer support

- This is a highlight each year for our students and community

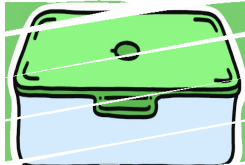


Pancake Breakfast - December 19 ECO Style!
