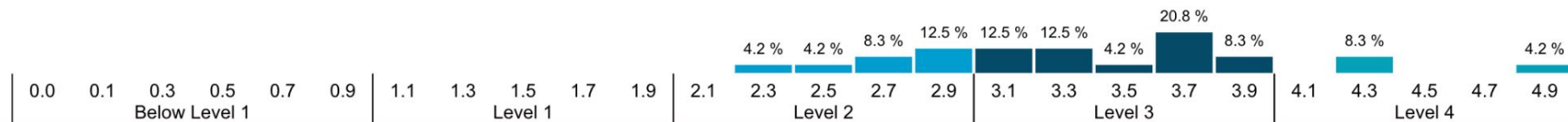

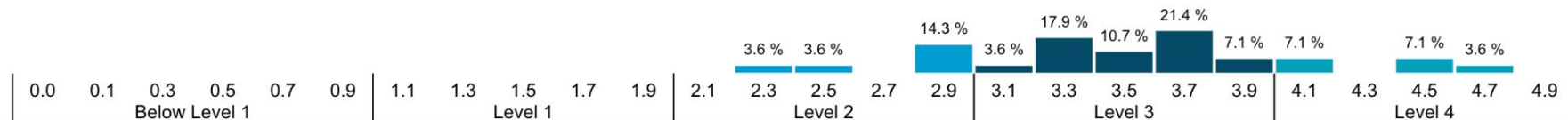

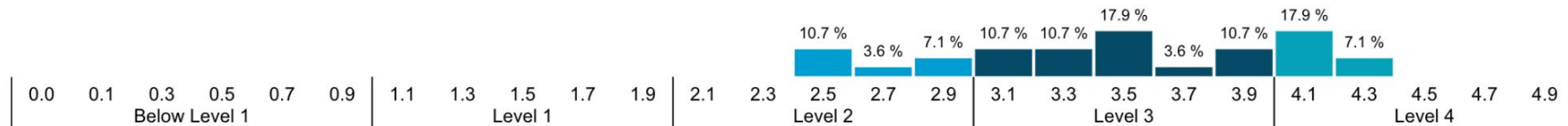

Results by Achievement at School Level

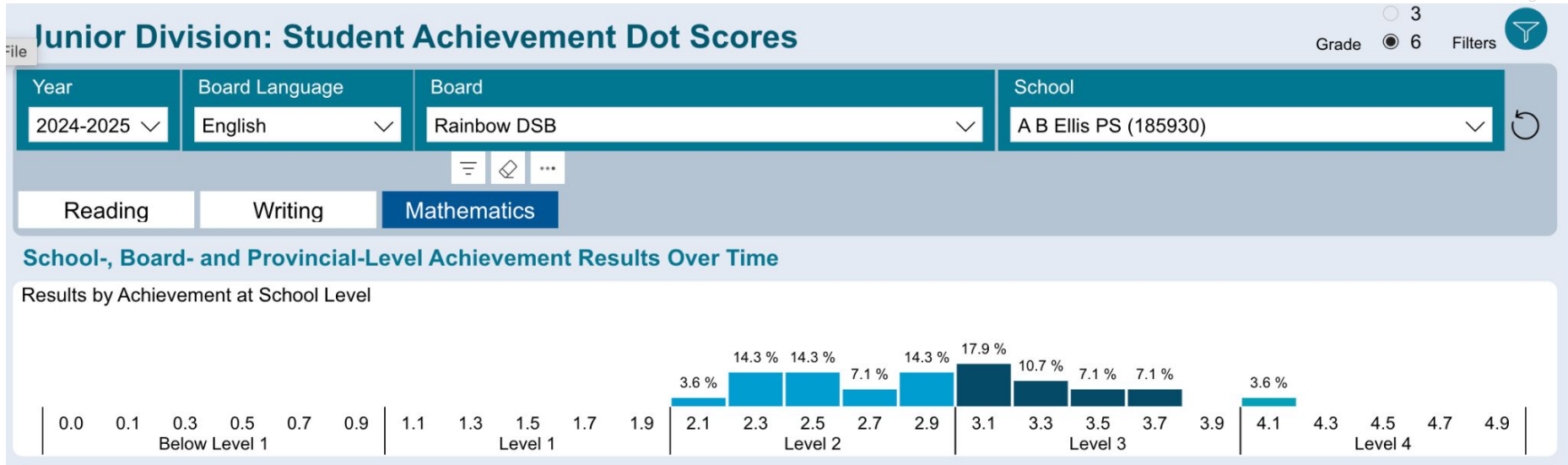


Results by Achievement at Board Level

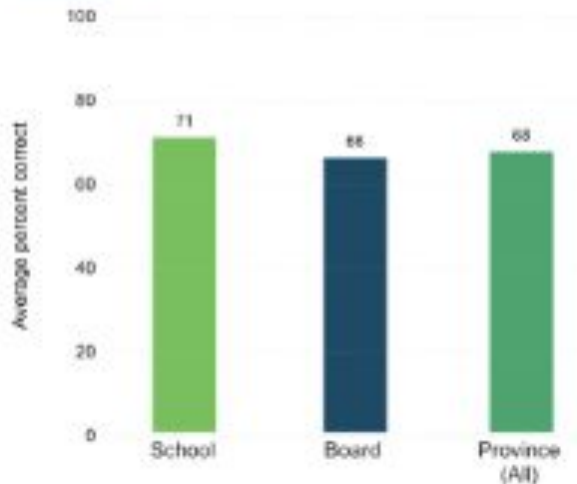

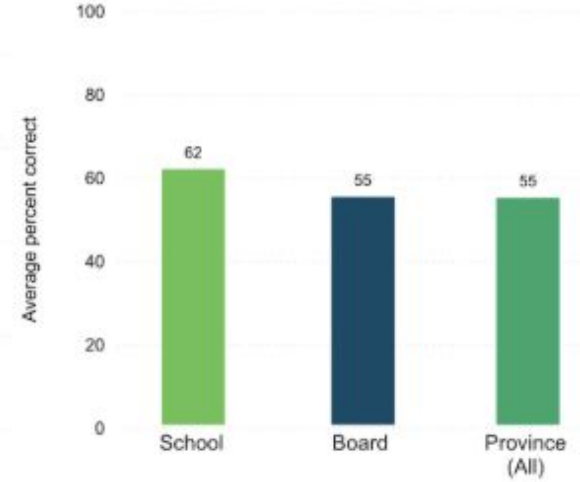

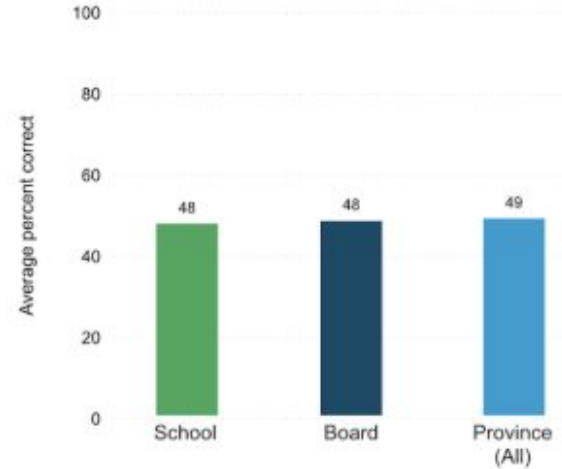

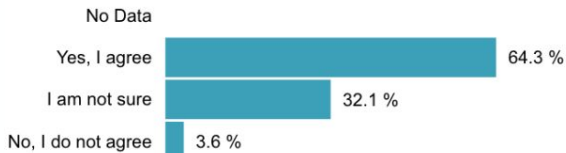

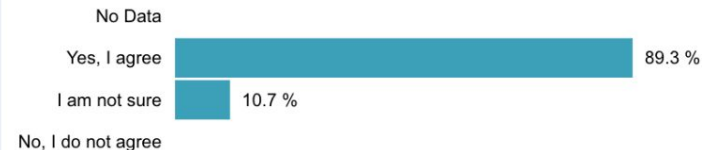

# Safe Schools Teams



- SIP plan
  - staff looking out for inappropriate comments that are derogatory/racist in nature and we discuss any updates during regular staff meetings
  - CARE kids (Caring Adult Reaching Everyone) -100% of AB Ellis students will be able to identify a caring adult whom they can reach out to for support (We have only 3 more students to build connections with)
  - Dare to Care (bullying prevention program) - All classroom teachers are to complete the lessons of the Dare To Care program (7/9 of our Gr. 1/2 - 7/8 classrooms are completed, with 2 nearly finished the program)
- Purchase a Buddy Bench for the yard
- Other areas to consider to continue to build a safe school environment?



# Food Drive & Christmas Raffle Baskets



- Our non-perishable food collection for the Espanola Helping Hand Food Bank resulted in 623 items donated to our neighbours in need
- We raised \$1263 from our raffle baskets to support student activities
